ASSESS

Is my company registered with the Information

Commissioner's Office (UK) or relevant public authority?

What <u>personal data</u> do we collect and store? Do our services directly collect <u>data from children</u> ?	Do we provide privacy notice to clients? How can they report a breach?
How do we handle <u>employee personal data</u> ?	Do we have a process for clients to request access or erase their personal data?
Where is personal data stored? Do we have a map of data flows?	How do we verify our data is accurate and up to date?
Does collected personal data always remain in the EU?	Do we provide <u>Data processing services</u> ?
Do we share any personal data? If yes, who receives our data? What data do they receive?	Is there a designated <u>Data Protection Officer</u> ? Is a DPO required for our business?
Is <u>consent</u> granted when data is collected? How do clients withdraw consent?	Have we completed a <u>Data Protection</u> <u>Impact Assessment</u> ?

GDPR READINESS CHECKLIST for DATA CONTROLLERS

PLAN

Engage legal consult for a GDPR assessment and implementation of controls	Define a data breach procedure
Create a data map	Complete a Data Protection Impact Assessment, if appropriate
Create a data retention policy	Define internal processes to handle personal information management requests
Create a data protection policy	Define a data audit plan

POST IMPLEMENTATION AUDIT

Are internal procedures adequately documented?	Can we successfully receive and process an individual's data privacy request to be forgotten?
For areas where request consent, can we later prove consent was given and by whom?	Are all internal teams trained on GDPR compliance and new GDPR compliant procedures?
If third party vendors are processing personal data on our behalf, do we have data processing agreements in place?	Do we have any outstanding risks and remediations documented?
