	Do we share any personal data? If yes, who receives our data? What data do they receive?
	Is consent granted when data is collected? How do clients withdraw consent?
	Is my company registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (UK) or relevant public authority?
	Do we provide privacy notice to clients? How can they report a breach?
	Do we have a process for clients to request access or erase their personal data?
	How do we verify our data is accurate and up to date?
	Do we provide data processing services?
	Is there a designated <u>Data Protection Officer</u> ? Is a DPO required for our business?
	Have we completed a <u>Data Protection Impact Assessment</u> ?

	Do we have any outstanding risks and remediations documented?
