

Evolve to Next-Level Endpoint Defense

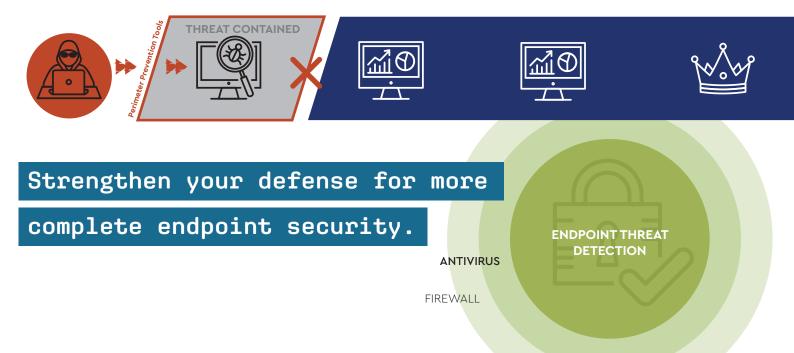

EDRs record and store endpoint/system-level behaviors and use various data analytics techniques to detect a broader range of suspicious behavior. Once a threat is known, remediation measures may include isolating the machine in question and system rollback to a pre-attack state.
